

## The Summer Classic Walleye Fishing Rules and Regulations:

Fishing area is all water reachable by boat on designated lake

- State limits will be allowed in boat but only 5 fish will be weighed, 2 over 20"
  - 15" minimum size limit
  - Walleyes/Saugers will be only fish permitted to be weighed
  - Any fish mangled, mashed, or mauled will only be weighed at advisory board discretion
  - Ties will be decided by big fish first, coin flip second
  - Only the initial 5 fish brought to the weighmaster will be considered for weigh-ins
  - You cannot go back to your live well to replace a fish that was thrown out by the weighmaster
  - Ineligible fish will not be weighed
  - Illegal fish will result in disqualification
  - Safe boating must be observed at all times
  - All contestants are expected to follow high standards of sportsmanship ○
    - Please respect other competitors and non-competing fisherman's boundaries and space. If you are working shorelines and a boat is anchored within casting distance of the shallows, it is unsportsmanlike to go between that boat and the shoreline. Same situation but the boat is not anchored, use common courtesy, and discuss right-of-way with the other boat before passing each other.
- Anyone with a valid fishing license and paid entry is eligible. Kids under 16 don't go against the maximum. 4 person max team.
- Fishing Rules will take place on Friday, June 6th at 6:30 PM at Lake Region Golf Club
- Check in and boat checks will begin at 6:00am on Saturday, June 7th  
FLIGHT 1: 7:00am | FLIGHT 2: 7:30am
- No late take off penalty, but please call ahead
- GPS will be used as official time of take offs
- Late weigh-in arrival results in disqualification
  - Have your boat off plane within 1/4 mile of the boat ramp before the official GPS time strikes 3:01pm for first flight and 3:31pm for second flight
  - For offsite weigh-in location at Lake Region Golf Course, you must report

immediately to the weigh station after loading your boat (Any team arriving at the weigh-in location 5 minutes or more after the last team to weigh-in will not be allowed to weigh their fish)

- Anyone caught cheating will be immediately disqualified and banned from future events
- All laws set forth by the South Dakota Game Fish and Parks must always be followed
- Top placing Lake Area Walleye Club team will automatically qualify for the 2025 LAWC Championship event.
