

Ty Eschenbaum Foundation Scholarship

Scholarship open to applicants who are youth cancer survivors or who are currently battling with cancer.

NEW FOR 2024! Open to all high school seniors graduating from a South Dakota school district in 2024 *or* graduates of a South Dakota high school who will be enrolled in college as a freshman, sophomore, or junior in the fall of 2024.

i.e. students can apply for four years of college, regardless of previously applying or previously being awarded funds.

Up to \$25,000 in scholarships will be awarded in 2024.

Scholarship submissions are due by March 31, 2024 and awards will be announced before May 15, 2024.

Scholarships will be paid directly to the educational institution for the fall semester following proof of enrollment.

About the Scholarship:

Ty Eschenbaum is a Leukemia survivor from Lake Preston, SD. Diagnosed at the age of 15, Ty spent most of his high school days battling this disease and finished his last round of chemotherapy just a few months before his high school graduation.

The Ty Eschenbaum Foundation was founded in 2011 to recognize and support those individuals and families that have fought cancer at a young age. Although these survivors have been through more than some will experience in a lifetime, their lives are true inspirations to those around them. Recipients of a TE Foundation scholarship are honored for playing the cards they were dealt, for showing great courage and a positive attitude during very troubled times.

We believe these students will carry their tenacity and outlook on life forward, to accomplish great things wherever their life takes them. We simply wish to recognize and support them with their endeavors.






